W. Stephen Gunter earned his undergraduate and first master degree here at Southern Nazarene University. He went on to Nazarene Theological Seminary for a Master of Divinity and Leiden University in the Netherlands for his Ph.D.

He returned to SNU as a professor before moving to the Candler School of Theology at Emory University. He also served as President of Young Harris College in northern Georgia. In 2007 he became Research Professor of Evangelism and Wesleyan Studies at the Duke Divinity School where he served as Associate Dean. He retired in 2017 and is now Theologian in Residence at the Church of the Servant.
